COVID

Particular COVID Points to Note:

(Please see plan for full details)

- Parents/ Guardians/ Spectators are required to follow the Chief Health Officers' Directions for public gatherings and maintain physical distancing of 1.5 metres – Parents/ Guardians/ Spectators should be in groups of no more than 10 and spread out around the venue.
- It is recommended for Parents/ Guardians/ Spectators to remain in their cars until matches are about to start. Players can enter earlier to partake in warm-up activities.
- Please leave the venue promptly at the end of your game.
- Penalty Corners Face Masks are to be allocated to a player for the game and only that player is to touch or wear that facemask. Players need to put their mask behind the goal themselves.
- Spitting and bushman nose blowing (blowing your nose without a handkerchief or tissue etc.) is a practice that occurs in sport and must stop as it poses a risk to other participants. Umpire will be guided to:
 - Issue a verbal caution to any player or participant caught spitting or bushman nose blowing.
 - Show a yellow card (5 mins) to repeat offenders (i.e. player(s) offending more than once).
- If participating in more than 1 match in a day, players are to change their clothes, sanitise their equipment and wash their hands between matches.
- Bring your **full** water bottle with your name clearly visible on the bottle.
- No shared food including oranges or lollies.
- Each team is responsible for the sanitisation of player benches, dugouts and any other commonly used areas after that team's match. Sanitiser spray will be available at the Tech Bench on Pitch 1.
- Umpires & Team Managers to bring their own pens for the match books.
- Pipes will not be used for the edges of the pitches to avoid handling risks.

Junior State Championships (JSC)

On July 10th Hockey Vic understandably confirmed the cancellation of the Junior State Championships.

Hockey Victoria High Performance

There are no Hockey Vic High performance activities at the moment with the Metro lock down and Hockey Vic have stated that “With much uncertainty to hockey activities for the remainder of 2020 HV will continue to manage a significantly reduced administration during the coming months and seek further government support to ensure the organization has the appropriate resources restart the sport when we can.”

School Sports Victoria

Team Vic events including selection trials and training have been cancelled.

U18s

U18s Mixed Metro Comp will not go ahead this year. The Association will explore possibility of involving U18s in some matches later in season, possibly with other associations.

Hook into Hockey & Under 10s

Hin2H will resume on 18th July for 2 weeks and Hockey Sixers will start from the beginning of August.

There is no U10 competition this year due to low numbers so we are looking into the opportunity for U10s to join in with Sixers activities on Saturday Mornings from the beginning of August.
